We take this opportunity to congratulate you on your soon-to-be graduation from TCCHS, a school the TCCHS Alumni Association holds dear to our hearts. You will find provided to you the scholarship application cover sheet as well as a copy of the scholarship application provided by the TCCHS Alumni Association. We have tried to make the application process as easy as possible. We have also explained the procedure and our expectations to Ms. Amber Gant, TCCHS guidance counselor, and to Mrs. Rachel Westerman, TCCHS Career Counselor.

We have also made changes in the application process to make it easier for everyone who meets the criteria for scholarships and wants to apply for them. We encourage you to make certain you meet all of those requirements. Each scholarship, except those few identified on the cover sheet, must have **four** letters of recommendation. Please make certain that you **DO NOT** have letters from family members. We have had to disqualify students in the past who have included letters from family, and we want to caution you about that requirement. Please also note **two** of the four letters must be from **educators**, and the other **two** must be from **non-educators**. Remember **NO** letters can be provided by family members!

The association has been fortunate to offer again this year a \$1000 scholarship, the **Todd County Chamber of Commerce Academic or Technical Scholarship**. This scholarship, as the organization has requested, will require applicants to submit an additional essay requested by the directors of the Chamber. Please note the requirements for this essay as you complete the scholarship process.

We are also very pleased Novelis-Guthrie has joined our scholarship effort this year with this new industry in Todd County providing five \$1000 scholarships to the TCCHS Class of 2022. We have also been blessed in very recent days with an anonymous donor of another \$1000 scholarship geared for students pursuing a technical career. The exact specifics of this scholarship have not been finalized.

Please also note that because of the pandemic changes may be necessary. However, every effort will be made to keep all seniors informed of those changes. If you have questions, please talk with Mrs. Westerman or Ms. Gant. Again, we have worked diligently to make the process easy for you. We wish you success not only for the remainder of this year but in your post-graduate journey as well.

INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE NOTE – ALL SCHOLARSHIP LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION SHOULD BE FROM NON-FAMILY MEMBERS. SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRE FOUR LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION UNLESS NOTED. TWO OF THOSE FOUR MUST BE EDUCATORS (NON-RELATED), AND TWO MUST BE FROM NON-EDUCATORS (NON-RELATED).

1. Please check the box of each scholarship below for which you are applying and are qualified for consideration.
2. Fill out only **one** application **even if you are applying for multiple scholarships**.
3. Next, obtain the documents required for each scholarship you wish to be considered for when the TCCHS Alumni Association Scholarship Committee meets; note all scholarships, except the two with “Carolyn Wells” in their name and the “Shooting Sports Archery Scholarship” require **four letters of recommendation, two from non-family educators and two from non-family members. Note: Your application is rejected if letters are from family members.**
4. Turn in **this cover sheet, one scholarship application, and your documents and letters** to Mrs. Westerman or your guidance counselor not later than **May 1**.
5. Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection prior to the recognition program for scholarship recipients.
6. Scholarship money will be paid out to the university or technical school by the TCCHS Alumni Association after the recipient provides proof of registration at a post-secondary school, whether that be a technical school, college, or university. Your **student ID number** for the college or technical school you plan to attend **must also be provided** to the association for check-writing purposes.
7. Please remember alumni and friends of the association are generating the monies for these scholarships. “Thank you” notes **are requested** to be sent to those scholarship sponsors as soon as possible after being awarded a scholarship.

Please read application completely before you begin this process. If a line does not apply to you, write NA (not applicable) on it to indicate that you have read it. Please print or type.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants **must be** residents of Todd County and 2022 graduates of Todd County Central High.
- For most scholarships applicants must have a 3.0 out of 4.0 GPA.
- For the **Tom and Rowena Everett Memorial Scholarship**, for the **Alton Greenfield Memorial Academic Scholarship**, and for the **Howard Ray Stokes Memorial Academic Scholarship**, the applicant must have a **3.5 out of 4.0 GPA** to be considered. These three scholarships place a major emphasis on **academics** rather than financial need.
- Applicants must be enrolled full time in a post-secondary institute such as a
 - four-year college or university, two-year or four-year vocational/technical school
 - or an institute.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the post-secondary institution upon official notification of enrollment from the registrar. Funds will **not** be made payable to any individual. The funds can be applied to tuition, books, and college-related fees. Funds must be used within the first two semesters, Fall 2022 or Spring 2023. By Feb.15, 2023, any unused funds will be returned to the TCCHSAA Scholarship Fund and used for future scholarships.

Selection Criteria:

Please note the specific selection criteria listed on each of the scholarships on the cover sheet.

A committee will review and give careful consideration to each application. There will be no discrimination based upon sex, race, national origin, religion, or special needs. The decision of the committee is final. School personnel and committee members will keep all information provided in complete confidence. All

applications, except for that of the awardee, will be shredded at the end of this process to protect private information. Your guidance counselor will be notified following the meeting of the selection committee.

Each eligible applicant must

- Enclose a current high school transcript.
- Attach **two current letters of recommendation from educators** (non-family members).
- Attach **two current letters of recommendation from non-educators** (non-family members).
- Type a **two-page essay** (12-point font and double-spaced) expressing why he or she wants to be considered for this scholarship. The essay must address the area of collegiate study chosen and the applicant's goals. **An essay longer than two pages will be disqualified**).
- Note for the **Todd County Chamber of Commerce Academic or Technical Scholarship**, an additional essay must be prepared for this scholarship to discuss one of the following two topics. The essay should not exceed two pages, be double-spaced, and use 12-point font. The two topics are 1. *Explain how growing up in a small town will affect your ability to be a leader in the future.* **Or** 2. *Explain what our community can do to help our young people succeed and how that can be implemented.*
- Complete the entire application process.

Failure to meet eligibility or to complete information will disqualify your application.

Recipients shall not be eligible for renewal of the scholarship.

All applications must be given to the guidance counselor or Mrs. Rachel Westerman on or before May 1, 2022.
